Durham native Susan Hill (1948-2010) worked tirelessly as an advocate for women's reproductive health throughout her career, establishing clinics across the rural South and the nation — even in the face of grave danger. NARAL Pro-Choice North Carolina is proud to honor her memory through the presentation of the annual Susan Hill Award.

Ms. Allen was nominated for her decades-long commitment to women's rights. She is a lifelong activist with deep roots in North Carolina politics and the reproductive rights movement. In the early eighties, she was a strong advocate for the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) in North Carolina and worked within the Democratic Party to elect politicians who supported women's reproductive freedom. In 1997, she became the co-founder of Lillian's List, a political action committee that financially supports pro-choice Democratic women candidates for statewide office, which she continues to serve as board member emeritus.
